Grading Procedures:

Students will be graded on daily homework, quizzes/assessments, and projects. Homework will be graded for effort/completion. Class participation, work habits, and classroom behavior will be evaluated when determining student's character grade.

Organization is a key component in 6th grade. Student math binders and composition notebooks are tools we will use to keep all math related items organized and easy to locate. (Composition books were chosen so that items cannot be torn out of them.) Mathematics is a progression of concepts and the notebook will allow students to look back at previous work as a reference. Please assist your child in maintaining an organized math binder and notebook on a regular basis.

PRACTICE/RE-Enforcement Work:

Generally practice work is assigned on a DAILY BASIS except for Fridays. It is due the following school day. If the student does not have the assignment, a **ZAP** will be given to the student. A zero grade will be assigned until the assignment is completed and returned. The majority of the practice problems are taken from the Applications, Connections, and Extensions (A.C.E.) section of the textbook, vocabulary and additional practice sheets. Students are expected to keep all assignments clearly labeled and in order.

Student Expectations:

Students are expected to come to class **PREPARED** with his/her math binder (textbook, notebook and practice work inside), pencil(s), and pen to check work. When absent, it is the **STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY** to get and make up all work that was missed by checking what is posted in class and/or on the Blackboard site.
